Required in your application

- Project/program name and amount requested (\$200-\$1,000)
- How will funding enrich student learning?
- How many students will directly benefit?
- Budgeted items for project

The following categories will not be funded with few exceptions:

- Standard curriculum and textbooks
- Technology equipment that is part of the 1:World initiative or 509J Innovation Grants
- General school supplies and equipment (document cameras, smart boards)

The CPSF application form must be used and supplemental materials are not accepted. Your grant application must be pre-approved by your building administrator. Applications are provided in MS Word document format.
